### Logo - Colours

The Érudit logo can be used in red, white or black, but never in any other colours. In order to maintain its consistency, the logo may not be displayed with other colour combinations.

#### Logo - Size

The size of the logo is approximatly  $\pm$  1/4 the size of the document on which it is placed. It can be lightly adjusted if needed.

#### Graphics

We strongly advise to use, or adapt, our current illustrations. If possible, here are some elements to respect:

White space must take up approximately 1/2 to 1/3 of the space.

## Page Layout

Hierarchy	Favour tones of grey, rather than varying font sizes, to create a clear hierarchy of content throughout the document.
Alignment	Favour left-aligned text, rather than justified or centered text. Centered text is reserved for specific uses, such as: tote bags, banners, t-shirts – where the logo is displayed on its own.
Typeface Colour	If possible, use red text (as specified on p. 2 of this document) for covers and special elements.
Coloured Backgrounds	Do not use coloured backgrounds for long paragraphs or blocks of text.
