In the article “Mental Health Recovery Outcomes of students attending a hospital-based Recovery College in Canada” the authors wish to correct the reported scores.

Personal mental health recovery total scores (n=24) after attending the Recovery College (M=55.46, SD=12.4) were significantly higher than before attending the Recovery College (42.38, SD=12.8); $t(23) = -6.31, p=0.000$.
