**All entries** must be submitted by mail. No faxed, digital, or emailed submissions are allowed.

**One short-fiction** entry is one story (6,000 words maximum).

**One poetry entry** is up to 3 poems; no more than 100 lines per poem.

**Entry Fee:** \$30 for an entry from Canada and \$36 for an international entry. The entry fee includes a one-year subscription to *The Fiddlehead*.

**Multiple entries** are allowed; however, each entry must be accompanied by its own cover letter and entry fee.

**Deadline: postmarked by 1 December 2010**
