Papers read at the annual meetings of the Association are printed in the Annual Reports (now titled *Historical Papers*), space permitting. Copies of Reports from 1923 to date, with the exception of 1927, 1937, 1938, 1942-1953, which are out of print, are still available. The price is \$4.00 per copy up to that of 1968, and \$6.00 for subsequent issues. An index to the Reports for the years 1922 to 1951 is available at \$1.50 per copy; a similar index for the years 1952 to 1968 is available at \$1.00 per copy.

Ces Rapports annuels (maintenant intitulés *Communications Historiques*) contiennent les travaux lus aux assemblées annuelles, dans la mesure du possible. On peut obtenir les Rapports des années 1923 jusqu'à aujourd'hui, à l'exception de ceux de 1927, 1937, 1938, 1942-1953, dont les exemplaires sont épuisés. Le prix est de \$4.00 la copie jusqu'en 1968, et de \$6.00 à partir de 1968. Un index de tous les travaux publiés entre 1922 et 1951, groupés selon l'année, l'auteur et le sujet, se vend \$1.50; un index semblable pour les années 1952 à 1968 est disponible à \$1.00 la copie.
