Dans la mesure du possible, les informations reçues ont été vérifiées dans les publications elles-mêmes.

Circulating exhibitions (indicated by an asterisk) bear the exhibition dates of the originator only, regardless of whether other showings occurred prior to or after those dates. When such exhibitions were intended only for circulation in other institutions, the date and place of first showing is given under the name of the organizer. Unless otherwise indicated, the title of the accompanying publication is that of the exhibition. Information supplied has been verified where possible against the publications themselves.
