événements socio-politiques qui les ont entourées, les mémoires d'Alfred Charpentier sont intéressants, ils permettent de se rendre compte que cette période de l'histoire du Québec n'a pas suffisamment été étudiée en profondeur. Elle mériterait d'être analysée à fond parce que, pour juger de l'évolution actuelle du Québec, il faut se reporter à l'état des esprits au cours de cette période.

Ces événements expliquent bien mieux d'ailleurs que le fait de la guerre le résultat des élections provinciales de 1939 au cours desquelles le gouvernement de l'Union nationale fut battu.

Et c'est le long conflit au cours duquel Alfred Charpentier demeure président de la C.T.C.C. Pour les syndicats, c'est une période où ils ne peuvent guère jouer leur rôle de novateurs dans l'action sociale. Dans cette partie de ses mémoires, l'auteur s'arrête à un mouvement bien oublié aujourd'hui, mais qui eut son époque de notoriété : **Le Réarmement moral**. L'auteur, semble-t-il, s'y est engagé assez profondément et il raconte longuement les relations qu'il a eues avec ses leaders tant en Amérique qu'outre-mer, en particulier un séjour qu'il fit au centre de ralliement de ce regroupement dans le Michigan au mois d'août 1944.

Au congrès de 1946, M. Charpentier est remplacé par Gérard Picard à la

tête de la C.T.C.C. Il devient alors directeur du service technique et s'occupe d'éducation syndicale jusqu'en 1950, met au point un projet de Collège du Travail qui reste sur la table. Il est alors nommé membre de la Commission de relations ouvrières, fonction qu'il assume pendant dix ans.

Dans ces quelque quatre cents pages, Alfred Charpentier, au fil des événements qu'il rappelle, porte jugement sur les personnes et sur les choses. C'est un dossier qu'il présente. Il s'agit du point de vue d'un homme sincère, sensible et idéaliste qui a, par vocation, consacré ses talents et ses énergies à la classe ouvrière dont il était issu.

Sur les mêmes événements et sur les mêmes hommes, d'autres porteront un jugement bien différent. Et, plus tard, lorsque les historiens auront à se pencher sur cette période de l'histoire syndicale et à en dégager les lignes de force, il leur faudra prêter attention au témoignage d'Alfred Charpentier qui, malgré une vie professionnelle et publique, toute marquée d'échecs et de déboires rendus plus cruels par la grande sensibilité de l'homme, n'a jamais renoncé à lutter et combattre avec opiniâtreté pour ses opinions et ses idées. Et ses « mémoires mêmes n'ent-ils pas la meilleure illustration ? !
